Business Policy

- Reducing property taxes of small business to make Edmonton a competitive and attractive market;
- Opening an international office for investment from China and India, starting with Chengdu as a 2nd “twin city” to connect businesses in Edmonton and overseas; and,
- Allocating funds to encourage new media production around the world to showcase Edmonton as an international brand.

Transportation Policy

- Incorporate a “master” plan to integrate the outlying communities including St. Albert, Leduc and Sherwood Park;
- Review the benefits and advantages of combining LRT+BRT;
- Explore the construction of a union station to **share** public and private transportation from our downtown core to the international airport; and,
- Introduce a moratorium on bike lanes downtown until we can evaluate the success of wider neighbourhood sidewalks that share a pathway between pedestrians and cyclists.

Green Policy

As a sustainable and responsible city, we will:

- Install more electrical charging stations;
- Replace the use of pesticides with natural alternatives; and,
- Ensure that environmental data is accessible to the public.

Neighbourhood Development and Safety Policy

- Create safer communities by funding neighbourhood policing and preventative programs;
- Consult citizens before defining infill and lot- splitting policies;
- Increase affordable density with approved duplex basement renovations and garage suites; and,
- Improve permit approval process times.

Human Resources Policy

To ensure we attract and retain the best talent, we will reform the City of Edmonton Human Resources Branch to:

- Incorporate a 360-degree review in the City of Edmonton for all employees;
- Build an office of safe disclosure for city employees;
- Encourage diversity training for all employees in the City of Edmonton; and,
- Ensure fair representation of demographics in agencies, boards and commissions.
